




Number of Social Economy Organisations per 10,000 population by LA


number of trading social businesses by industrial sector in the west midlands




number of trading social businesses by turnover





number of trading social businesses by employees





Business Support

Start £15k to £50k pa. Grant of £2000 per participant Delivered by Enterprise Nation in partnership with becleaps (aka Birmingham Enterprise Community) x 42

Build £50k to £100k pa. Grant of up to £5,000 per participant Delivered by Locality. X 20

Grow £100k to £500k. Grant of up to £10,000 per participant Delivered by Aston University/Business School x 42

Accelerate £500k + pa. Grant of up to £20,000 per participant Delivered by Aston University/Business School. X 15

Coventry, Solihull, Birmingham (x3), Sandwell, Walsall, Dudley & Wolverhampton


An investment of £50k in each cluster


