Accessible transport is a vital support system for their members and their families. As demand for their services increases, so too has the need for transport. This has led to additional pressure on journey times, which is challenging for both members, their families and staff.

SOLUTION

ISpectrum Days has made a significant investment in expanding and upgrading their transport fleet. The purchase of new, fully adapted vehicles has strengthened their ability to provide safe, reliable and dignified transport for individuals with profound and multiple learning disabilities.

REVENUE

93% of the charity's income comes from three local authorities and remaining 7% of income is generated via grants and donations.

The recent expansion and upgrade of Spectrum Days' transport fleet has made a meaningful difference in the lives of their members and their families. With the addition of fully accessible vehicles, they have greatly enhanced the comfort, reliability, and efficiency of their transport service.
